- ✓ Safe Families for Children –There were 23 calls for help in April from families in distress. We were able to host 12 children, which brought our hostings for April to 24!!
 - Please pray for more family coaches and host families. Please pray that people who have expressed interested in serving with SFFC will take the next steps.
 - Will be part of a video being put together through The University of Sioux Falls for Safe Families for Children
- ✓ Willing Wheels to Wellness
 - Please pray for a driver coordinator—not sure having 10 different social workers contacting our drivers is going to work. Still in the test phase. Deb Thalhuber and I met with pastors from Hillcrest Baptist and Peace Lutheran churches about Willing Wheels to Wellness about the possibility of joining with CHARIS ministries and Project C.A.R.'s Healthy Rides ministry.
 - Last month I told you that we were currently trying to find rides for a blind man who goes to dialysis every Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturdays. He needs to be dropped off at 6:30 am and brought back home at 12:30 pm. He qualifies for para-transit and only has to pay \$2.50 per ride. But when you take that times 6 rides a week, just his dialysis treatment rides are at least \$60 a month, and his instructor said this is very difficult financially. I am happy to let you know that two drivers have committed to driving Sergio to his appoints on Tuesdays (Mike Weber) and Thursdays (Steve Fisher). If you see them, please thank them for this commitment to ministering to the under-resourced in our community.
