Expense:

 November was a 3 pay period month, since we pay biweekly we had 6 weeks of wages compared to 4 weeks of income. December will have 5 weeks of income and 4 weeks of wages so we should be able to make up some of the deficit this coming month.

Tuition Billing

Tammy will be taking over the tuition billing/family accounts beginning 12/30 and will be using brightwheel our current communication app. This will allow parents to have access to their statements, payment history and mange their account at anytime. We will also be adding a credit card option but parents will be automatically charged the merchant fee of 2.9% when using credit card. We have 5 families currently paying by check or cash. They will be allowed to continue to do so but will pay a \$5 per payment transaction fee, as those payments have to be manually entered and the payments brought to the bank. All drafts from a bank account will be at no cost to the family.

This process of switching over has been fairly time intensive the past couple weeks as I needed to update the tuition policies, payment authorization form. I also created onboarding instructions. The reoccurring billing charges also need to be entered. However, once all this is completed, I will need to add manual payments, make updates, add one time charges and add free day credits.
