- ✓ Safe Families for Children There were 19 calls for help in January from families in distress. SFFC was able to host 5 children from 2 families. We were unable to find a host family for one child and another family turned down the help offered by a potential host family. We are continuing to follow the needs of 3 other families which may result in a hosting request. Medical emergencies, mental health, and homelessness were the majority of the crises causing families to need assistance. We have seen a trend in increased behavioral challenges of the children whose parents are experiencing a temporary crisis. And two families were declined because of the significance of the behaviors.
 - Please pray for more family coaches and host families. Please pray that people who have expressed interested in serving with SFFC will take the next steps.
