A need we see is so many kids are unable to go to sports camps because of the cost. We would like to offer a sports camp (free of charge) to kids in the lower income neighborhoods who do not get the opportunity otherwise. We have reached out and have the ability to work with Augustana athletes. We are planning a basketball camp because this is something that both boys and girls could be interested in. Whittier school has sent over paperwork to utilize their facility. Our goal for this day would be to bring in volunteers from the colleges and volunteers from GNC and make it a camp similar to what you would go to elsewhere. Kenzie Erickson and Judy Decker have stepped up and said they would work on a young kids camp so middle school students that watch siblings could still attend. We would provide a meal, T-shirt, water bottle and morning camp. Looking at June 2020 for kids age 5th-8th grade. We will look at providing transportation for the kids. We have talked about partnering with Church on the Street because many of these kids are familiar with the kids in this neighborhood.
