
Dear Friends,

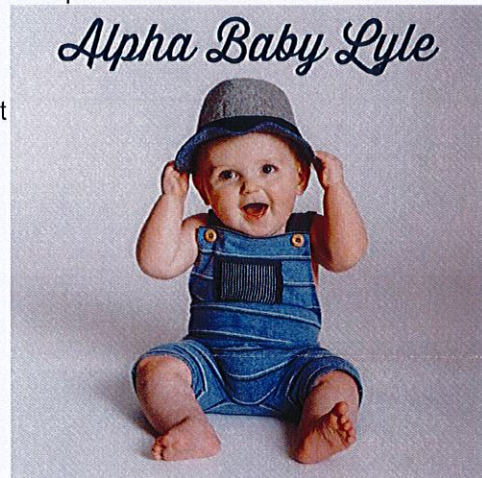

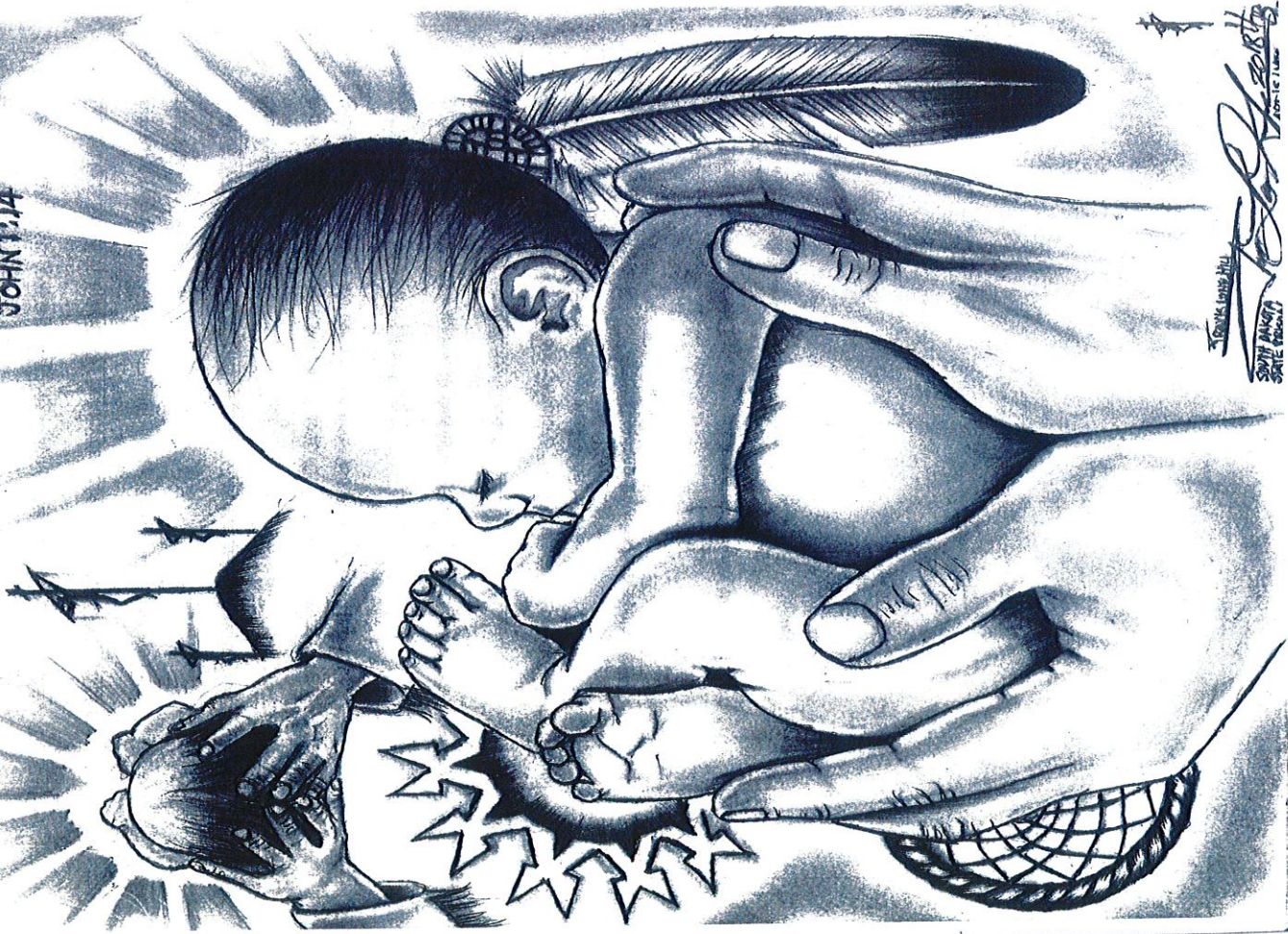
