1. Connection Groups

- a. My biggest push late summer and into the fall has been for Connection Groups. We just kicked off our four week series called "Better Together." The number of sign-ups went up quite a bit this last week so I'm really happy about that! We have had 15 paper sign-ups and 4 online sign-ups with more people interested each day.
- b. Each of the groups now have at least one person/couple that have signed up for it

Guest Retention

- a. I keep a list of all the guests that sign in on the friendship pad each week. I also keep track of times that they return after their first visit and any communication that I've had with them. (most people don't leave contact information)
 - i. From the beginning of June we have had 72 people/families that have attended for the first time.
 - ii. 9 of those people/families are people that I would consider "regular attenders" currently. That's 11%. (statistics show that a healthy number is 20%... not too far off!)
